



LA ePortal Overview:

What is LA ePortal?

The LA ePortal is an innovative tool that has been developed to provide a means by which a user/student can plan and monitor his or her academic progress from middle school through postsecondary education and into the workforce. The web-based interface serves as an educational and career planning tool; has the potential to improve student access; revolutionize student engagement and articulation; foster re-engagement for out-of-school students; and empower students to take proprietary interest in and responsibility for their academic progress. The LA ePortal facilitates academic and career pursuits to assist citizens in the many transitions they will encounter as they navigate the lifelong learning continuum.

Where do users go to access LA ePortal?

Online at www.laeportal.com

LA ePortal system requirements:

There is no software to load or special hardware to buy, all you need is a computer with Internet access. We strongly recommend using **Microsoft Internet Explorer** Browser for optimal performance and best viewing.

Where can LA ePortal be used?

Because LA ePortal is a web-based application, users can "Sign In" anywhere internet access is available including school, home, libraries, etc.

Who has access to LA ePortal?

LA ePortal is available to both Public and Private schools in Louisiana at no cost. Approximately 1000 schools have been pre-loaded into the system. Students, educators, and parents can all create their own, personal LA ePortal accounts.

How do Students get an LA ePortal account?

1. Go to www.laeportal.com
2. Select the "K – 12 Students" tab on the main menu
3. Next, click the "Check Pre-Approval button"
4. Students can verify if their account has been "Pre-Approved" for instant access by correctly matching their First Name, Last Name and SSN.
5. If there is a match, they can proceed to selecting a school and creating a username and password.

If verification is not successful:

6. Students can always proceed directly to the Registration page.
7. Student account will be pending until the site administrator approves them.

What if I don't see my school in LA ePortal drop down list?

Contact the LA ePortal helpdesk (Board of Regents at 225.342.4253) and they will set your school up in LA ePortal.

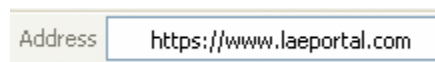

Is the LA ePortal system secure?

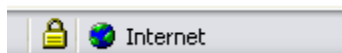
Yes. LA ePortal is a secure site with 128 bit encryption.

There are 2 ways you can tell that LA ePortal is a secure site:

1. In the address bar you will notice that it begins with **https://**, "s" meaning secure.



2. In the bottom of your browser you will notice a padlock indicating secure site.

3. Next, click the "Create an Account" button and begin creating your LA ePortal account.
4. Once you are finished, you will be granted instant access to your personal account.
